Minutes of the Annual Parish Meeting on Wednesday 17th April 2024 at St Mary's Church Birdlip at 7.30pm

1. **Attendance** The meeting was attended by 26 members of the public. Five members of the Parish Council and District Councillor Judd was also present.

2. **To receive apologies** apologies had been received from 8 residents.

3. **To receive the following Annual Reports**

- **Chairman of Parish Council** Cllr Lavington read out his detailed report to the meeting and thanked fellow Councillors and the Clerk for their work. Much had been achieved during 2023-2024 both by the Parish Council and residents, including the creation of a new History Group and Garden Cooperative. The chairman thanked Harvey Mattinson for representing the Parish Council at WCH meetings with National Highways. He also thanked the Speed watch Volunteers for their continuing work.

Looking forward, the Parish council would be replacing the Noticeboards, with the agreement of Gloucestershire Highways, replacing the road signs at the bus shelter with a heritage finger point sign. Thanks to a grant from the OPC Safer Streets fund the Parish Council would be looking to install CCTV throughout the village.
